Price adjustment within the TROX GROUP as of 1st June 2021

For over a year now, the Corona pandemic has had us all firmly in its grip. Even within the globally active TROX GROUP, we are feeling the manifold effects: In many places, our lives continue to be severely affected. Despite the very dynamic situation with permanent changes, we have done everything in our power to avoid possible delivery bottlenecks and other impairments so that we can continue to offer you the service you are accustomed to. Of course, we will continue to do so in the future.

Now, however, we too are being influenced by external factors that we have not yet experienced to the same extent. Above all, we are concerned about the increasing scarcity and the resulting price increase of raw materials.

In combination with limited supply and strongly increasing demand, the prices of steel, aluminium, plastics, copper, wood and logistics, among others, have risen, in some cases massively. We have not experienced such a development in recent decades, especially not in such a short period of time.

As there is unfortunately no relief in sight for the coming months, we will now react to the current situation and adjust the prices within the TROX GROUP by 6.9 % across the entire product portfolio as of 1 June 2021.

Of course, this step was not easy for us. However, in this difficult situation, the trust of our customers and partners in the TROX GROUP and a reliable readiness to deliver are our top priorities. Therefore, we are securing purchased parts, optimising processes and logistics, and looking for alternative ways. All of this leads to additional capacities and costs that we unfortunately can no longer absorb ourselves.
